
There is no adequate way to describe in words how much or what we have. The best way to find out is just to come and see it, but this brochure contains a small sample for those who don't yet know about us.

Our “School”

Some time back we had an opportunity to purchase the old Albuquerque Job Corps training center, a 40-acre complex complete with several buildings, a couple of quonset huts, a basketball gym with a wood floor and bleachers and trailer hook-ups where staff evidently lived. We have now begun to see how useful the site could be to the film industry. Our “school” could be used for a variety of settings: a school (not a stretch), an army base, a ranch, an abandoned town or government dormitory all come easily to mind. Recently a set decorator who was touring the site commented that he wished he had known about our gym; he was doing a high school movie and it took a while for him to find a school where he could rent one.

The site is bordered on two sides by Forest Service land, on two sides by paved roads, and it is virtually isolated from neighbors and the nearby town.
